What are these tests for?	Colleges use scores for admissions and merit-based scholarships.	
What is the cost <u>without</u> the essay?	\$55	\$60.00
What is the cost <u>with</u> the essay?	NA	\$85.00
What if the cost is a barrier to registering?	Contact your School Counselor	
What does it cover?	Reading, Writing & Language, Math	Reading, English, Science Reasoning, Math
How long is the test <u>without</u> an essay?	3 hours	2 hours & 55 minutes
How long is the test <u>with</u> the essay?	NA	3 hours & 40 minutes
How many Reading Passages are there?	5	4
Is there a Science section?	No	Yes
What Math concepts are covered?	Arithmetic, Algebra I & II, Geometry, Trigonometry, Data Analysis	Arithmetic, Algebra I & II, Geometry, Trigonometry, Probability, Statistics
